




What is Contact Evangelism?

Questions to ask


- *Did you accept God's invitation to save you?*
- *Did He save you?*
- *If you die right now, where will you go?*
- *Are you 100% certain?*
- *How do you know? (Review 1John 5:13)*



Assurance forever



Questions to ask

- *If you died tonight, are you 100% certain you would go to heaven?*
- *If you died ten minutes ago, where would you be?*
- *If you die 10 years from now, where would you go?*



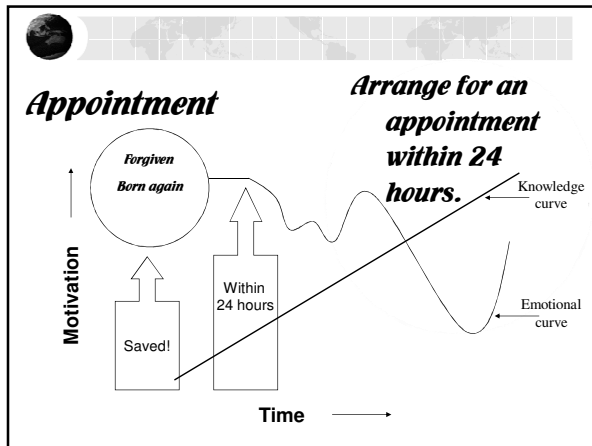



- Teachers ask questions and you answer them. This is what usually happens in school, right?
- However, consider research which suggests that the learning of technical information can be achieved by learning to ask good questions (Allison & Shrigley 79).
- Knowing how to ask good questions enhances your comprehension by focusing on main ideas and making connections among ideas. Very few students ask thought-provoking or higher-level questions about content they are learning in class or through independent projects.
- Asking questions will increase your comprehension of the subject matter.

Master, which is the great commandment in the law? Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.
